Marie Curie Cancer Care is a charity helping those affected by cancer - the UK's biggest killer. Every year the charity provides care to around 30,000 cancer patients and their families - entirely free of charge and for almost half of all cancer patients who die at home. These nurses are supported across the UK by Nursing Team Managers.

In fulfilling their role of supporting, coordinating and managing, Nursing Team Managers have many pressures on their time; therefore a more efficient means of handling the administrative tasks was required. Audata were able to provide Marie Curie with the solutions they needed.

Audata proposed their ProfIT solution (Professional Review of Filing and IT). This guided the Nursing Team Managers through a review and reduction of their paper and electronic filing, developed a filing structure and focused on which records to retain.

This software is practical and easy to use. It is browser-based so does not require a complicated IT structure and will work on any PC.
